PARENTS REACHING OUT GRANT

We help schools deliver Parents Reaching Out (PRO) Grant eligible projects, from application to evaluation. All publicly-funded School Councils in Ontario are eligible for up to \$1,000. Application deadline is May 25, 2017. Funds must be spent by June 30, 2018.
